Starting out with Lovebirds All Lovebirds come from the mainland of Africa, with the exception of the tiny Madagascar Lovebird, which comes from the Malagasy Republic (formerly known as Madagascar) All in all there are 9 species of Lovebird, although only eight have been available in captivity

#### Status of the Rosy-faced Lovebird in Phoenix, Arizona

The Rosy-faced Lovebird was first reported as breeding in the greater Phoenix area in a residential neighborhood in the East Valley near the Apache Junction and Mesa city border in 1987 (Michael A Moore pers comm) Further documentation of nesting of Rosy-faced Lovebirds was published in the Arizona Breeding Bird Atlas (Corman 2005)

A QUICK GUIDE TO SMALL PARROTS: BUDGIES, COCKATIELS AND LOVEBIRDS Change cage papers and disinfect food and water dishes daily Clean and disinfect the cage at least once a week Toys and perches will need occasional disinfecting as well Replace wooden perches periodically as they cannot be properly disinfected Rinse all items thoroughly

### **Unusual lesions associated with avian poxvirus infection ...**

At the time of the outbreak there were 160 breeder pairs and 400 young lovebirds, 130 breeding pairs, and 200 young cockatiels, and 300 breeder pairs and 500 young finches The disease occurred only in lovebirds and caused a high inci-dence of mortality in young birds (150/400) and low mortality in breeders (5/160)

### **Lovebirds Lilian's Lovebirds aka Nyasa Lovebirds (Eye-ring)**

Breeding The breeding season for Lilian's Lovebirds is from January to April and in June and July They make a roofed nest in tree crevices in mopane trees In captivity the clutch consists of three to eight white eggs, which are incubated for about 22 days, and the chicks leave the nest after about 44 days from hatching Aviculture
